The 2023 North American Indigenous Games will be held July 15-23, 2023, in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

CALL FOR COACHES

The Manitoba Aboriginal Sports & Recreation Council (MASRC)* is now accepting applications for **COACH (VOLUNTEER)** positions. Positions are available for various sports that will be held at 2023 NAIG.

*The MASRC is the recognized Province/Territorial Aboriginal Sport Body (P/TASB) that oversees the operations of Team Manitoba. Team Manitoba will be comprised of approximately 448 athletes, 80 coaches, managers, chaperones, and mission staff.

COACH POSITION DESCRIPTION

In conjunction with MASRC staff and respective Sport Managers, coaching staff are required to participate in all aspects of team selection, training, supervision, and guidance of athletes attending the Games. Coaching staff are required to abide by the policies; rules and regulations; and other guidelines handed down by the MASRC, the NAIG Council, and the 2023 NAIG Host Society.

Coaching staff will consist of a Head Coach and a support staff - either Assistant Coach or Trainers (all selected through an application process).

General Roles & Responsibilities

Pre-Games:

- Assist with athlete identification camps, qualifying events/camps, and athlete registration.
- Provide ongoing athlete training and monitoring from selection to competition
 - Includes organizing opportunities for teams/individuals to practice, and conduct those practices

At Games:

- Mentor the athletes as a coach
- Supervision of athletes 24/7 in partnership with the manager/chaperones
 - Includes perimeter and bed checks at curfew

Post-Games:

- Provide a written evaluation of:
 - Aspects of team operations relating to responsibilities as a coach
 - General event overview

Criteria to Apply as a Coach

- □ Must be at least 18 years of age when application is submitted
- □ Must be of good character
- □ Must be physically fit (I.e., Ability to stand for long period of time, walk long distances)
- □ NCCP Certification in their respective sport
 - Sports have different requirements for Head and Assistant Coaches
- Aboriginal Coaching Module (ACM) Certified
- **Generation** Respect in Sport Certification (Available online only)
- □ First Aid/CPR Training is an Asset
- □ Valid Driver's License is an Asset

IMPORTANT:

- Preference will be given to coaches of Indigenous (First Nation, Metis and Inuit) descent.
- You CANNOT coach a team that your child/grandchild/sibling is eligible to compete on
- If selected as a coach for 2023 NAIG, criminal record and child abuse checks will be REQUIRED.
