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MASRC ABORIGINAL COACH SCHOLARSHIP

The Manitoba Aboriginal Sports & Recreation Council annually presents \$600 scholarships to two Aboriginal students who have demonstrated a commitment to coaching in Manitoba. Our goal is to encourage students to continue coaching while attending a recognized post secondary institute. All post-secondary students who are coaching for a school, club, or community centre, and are registered for the 2020/2021 academic session are invited to submit an application.

Scholarships will be awarded to those Aboriginal youth who have shown coaching leadership in Manitoba's amateur sport community through well rounded participation as a coach, as well as on the basis of academic standing, and other school/community related activities.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) The MASRC will award Coaching Scholarships to Aboriginal youth (up to 29 years of age) who are enrolling into a full time University or other recognized post-secondary institution.
- 2) Current full time post-secondary students, as defined by the post-secondary institute.
- 3) A candidate must have proficiency in sport, and have a minimum "C" (65%) average in his/her grades.
- 4) Currently coaching individuals/teams in Manitoba and plan on continuing their coaching duties.
- 5) National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) training is an asset.
- 6) Additional courses related to coaching (i.e. NCCP, CPR, First Aid, coaching seminars) are an asset.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

All candidates must complete the application form in full and provide the following required documents before being considered.

- 1) Proof of Aboriginal ancestry. Photocopy of Indian status, Métis, or Inuit card.
- 2) A letter from a school official, club representative, and/or community centre certifying the candidate's coaching duties. Should also indicate the candidate's character, involvement in other school or community programs, and service in the school or community.
- 3) Latest transcript of marks.
- 4) A paragraph describing the student's sport involvement and future plans in sport. Please comment on post-secondary, career and coaching aspirations as well.
- 5) Additional letters of support may be included but are not mandatory.

ONE MALE and ONE FEMALE applicant will be selected in MANITOBA each year.
