### **CAMP LOCATION**

Tim Horton Camp Whiteshell (THCW) is located on the beautiful shores of Sylvia Lake across the river from Pinawa, and just within the boundary of the Whiteshell Provincial Park. Located about a 1 hour drive north-east of Winnipeg, THCW is surrounded by cliff-edged rivers, clear deep lakes, and soaring pines. Program highlights at THCW include: multi-day backcountry canoe trips, wilderness survival skills, low ropes challenge course and waterfront activities.
